White Wine Selections Grüner Veltliner

It is a variety of white wine grape that is widely grown primarily in Austria and the Czech Republic, but almost nowhere else. It has a reputation for being a particularly food-friendly wine, being perhaps the single most versatile food wine in the world, often surpassing even Riesling because of its ability to pair with 'difficult' foods such as artichokes and asparagus.

Pinot Grigio, Pinot Gris & Pinot Blanc

Pinot Gris is a mutation of Pinot Noir and has a pinkish, light purple skin. In the classic region of Alsace, where Pinot Gris is classified as a noble grape variety, it tends to produce wines with a deep colour, full bodied in structure, yet soft and gently aromatic. In Italy (called Pinot Grigio) where it is grown more extensively, it tends to produce wines which are lighter bodied with subtler nuances of flavours.

Pinot Blanc is a genetic mutation or clone of Pinot Gris, which in turn is a clone of Pinot Noir. The leaf structure, clusters and berries so resemble Chardonnay that there are many vineyards in Europe where plantings of the two grapes are intermingled.

Generally, in Bordeaux it is blended with the aromatic Sauvignon Blanc to produce the fine dry whites of Pessac-Leognan in Graves. It is at its most illustrious in the region of Sauternes and Barsac, where it can produce the most luscious, sweet wines in the world. On its own, it is responsible for some of Australia's most individual dry white wines.

Cabernet Franc & Blends

If Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot are, respectively, considered as the King and Queen of Bordeaux's grape varieties, then Cabernet Franc will be its Prince. Cabernet Franc, the distant relative of Cabernet Sauvignon, can produce deliciously perfumed, supple, raspberry and blackcurrant-infused red wines in Bordeaux, while further North in the Loire Valley it tends to produce wines with aromas more reminiscent of herbs.

Dolcetto

A native black grape variety of Northern Italy grown almost exclusively in the provinces of Cuneo and Alessandria in Piedmont. It is relatively easy to cultivate, although it is susceptible to fungal diseases. It ripens before Barbera and Nebbiolo and is often grown in high north-facing sites which would be unsuitable for Nebbiolo. The finest Dolcetto wines come from grapes grown on soils rich with white marls, especially those found on the right bank of the River Tauro. The wines generally are low in tannins and acidity and are usually fruity and fragrant, often with hints of almonds.

Merlot is the most widely planted variety in Bordeaux, and tends to be the dominant grape in the lauded reds of the right bank – most famously in the Clarets of Saint-Emilion and Pomerol.

Red Wine Selections Malbec & Blends

At one time, Malbec was perhaps best-known as the grape responsible for Cahors, in south-west France (where it's known as cot) and for its blending role in clarets, with cabernet sauvignon, merlot, cabernet franc and petit Verdot. Nowadays, it is more likely to be identified with Argentina. The focus of Argentine plantings is in Mendoza, where Malbec yields a velvety, concentrated wine of high alcohol, fruit content and extract.

Syrah, or Shiraz as it is known in the New World, is considered to be one of the great noble black grape varieties, due to its ability to produce dark, full-bodied, age-worthy wines. In Northern Rhône, it reaches its apogee in the deep hued, muscular, long-lived wines of Hermitage and Côte Rôtie. It is a component of Southern Rhône reds and the fastest growing grape in France's Languedoc region. As Shiraz, it is Australia's most important red variety, where it forms the backbone of "Grange", "Runrig", "Hill of Grace" and "Factor" – Australia's most famous reds.

Sweet Temptations

There is no simple definition of a dessert wine. Dessert wines are sweet wines typically served with dessert, such as Sauternes, Constantia, Vin Santo, Tokaji Aszú, Eiswein or Ice wine, Trockenbeerenauslese, Beerenaulese or Recioto della Valpolicella. Despite the name they are often best appreciated alone or with fruit or bakery sweets. A dessert wine is considered to be any sweet wine drunk with a meal as opposed to the white fortified wines (fino and amontillado sherry) drunk before the meal, and the red fortified wines (port and madeira) drunk after it. Thus most fortified wines are regarded as distinct from dessert wines, but some of the less strong fortified white wines such as Pedro Ximénez sherry and Muscat de Beaumes-de-Venise are regarded as honorary desert wines.
