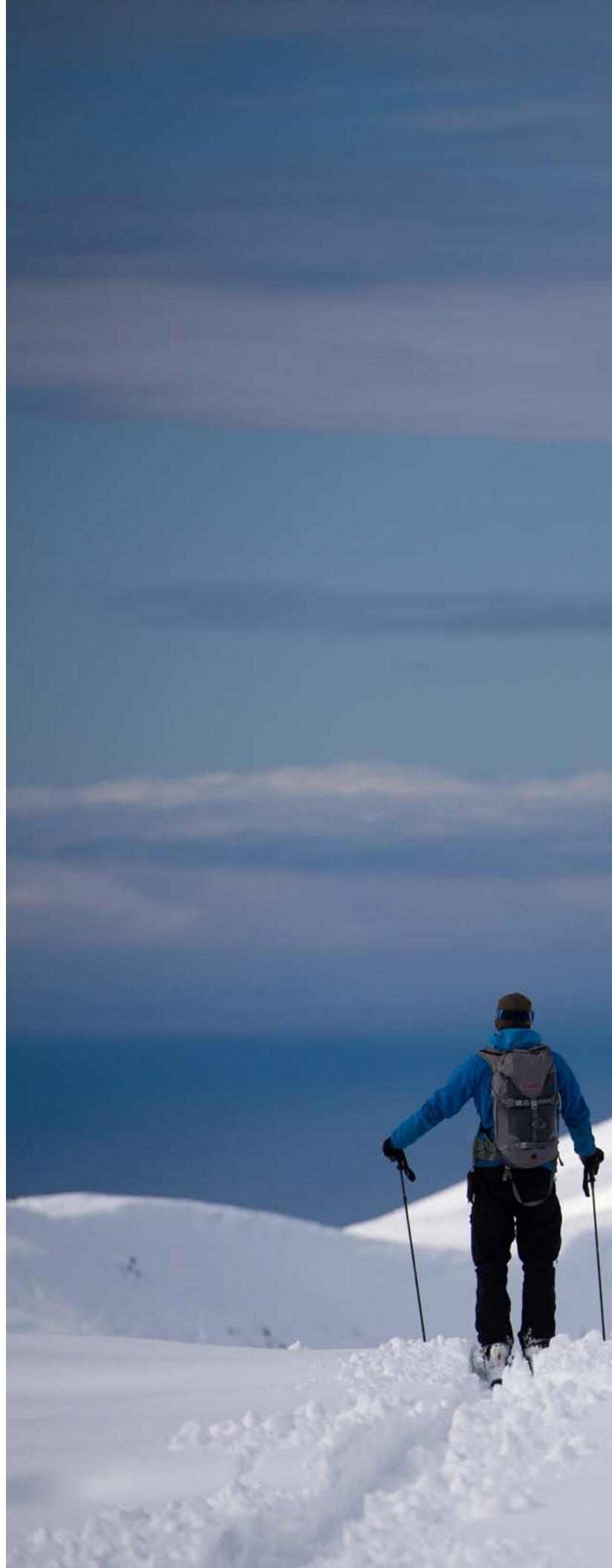

### ABOUT NORTHERN ICELAND

Iceland's unique geologic history has created an environment that is truly stunning. Mountains rise up from the sea along the fjords on the Troll Peninsula. The island is full of geothermal vents below the surface which form numerous hot springs throughout the country. Our proximity to the Arctic Circle allows for views of the Northern Lights from October to April, and long days in the summer mean more time to adventure and explore. Popular summer activities include fishing for Atlantic salmon and Arctic char, hiking, sea kayaking and horseback riding. In the spring, surfing and heli-skiing can be done in the same day.

Deplar is a converted sheep farm, situated in the remote Fljót Valley on the mountainous Troll Peninsula in northern Iceland. Today's modern structure celebrates a rugged past, and honors authentic Icelandic architecture with 13 en suite bedrooms. It is a one-stop-shop for adventure, solitude, mystery, and high-end amenities. The Fljót Valley sees some of the highest average snowfall on the planet. As a result, the eastern route to Deplar is closed all winter, making its remote locale all the more raw and wild. Strategically located between Europe and the States, Iceland and Deplar offer easy access to otherworldly landscapes without hours of traveling. New York and London-based clients can be fishing or skiing on the same day of travel.

# ACTIVITIES GUIDE





## ◀ YEAR-ROUND ACTIVITIES

The remote Troll Peninsula of northern Iceland is an outdoor enthusiast's paradise, and we encourage guests to explore the area as much as they can. We offer a variety of unforgettable guided adventures year round. If you are interested in any of these activities, the Experience Team will be more than happy to add them to your itinerary.

### WHALE WATCHING

The otherworldly landscape of Eyjafjörður is a must-see. Spot white beaked dolphins, humpback, blue and orca whales. Whale watching in Iceland is a truly unforgettable experience.

*Activity Duration: 1-3 hours. Travel Time: 1 hour. Group whale watching tours are included in your stay. Private whale watching comes at an additional cost.*

### SURFING

It's no surprise the North Atlantic ocean serves up enviable surf, but the quality of the breaks offers an element of surprise. Yes, it's cold. Yet outfitted with our 6/5/4 mm wetsuits, you'll be comfortable in the line up. Expect mostly right-handers, with an occasional left break. And you may just spot local pro surfer Heiðar Logi in his happy place.

*Activity Duration: Half day. Travel Time: 30 minutes. This activity is included in your stay.*

### HIKING

Hiking is one of our favorite ways to travel through the intoxicating landscape of the Troll Peninsula. Offered year-round, and for all levels of fitness, take an easy stroll in the Svarfaðardalur Nature Reserve or tackle a hard-charging ascent to steep peaks. Alternatively, stay close to your Eleven home and hike from Deplar Farm around nearby trails.

*Activity Duration: Guest preference. Travel Time: 30 minutes. This activity is included in your stay.*

### FAT BIKING

Discover frozen valleys during winter via fat tire snow bikes. These man-powered bikes have fat tires to float through the snow (and we promise a workout, too). Fat biking is equally fun come summer, with private trails located in our nearby mountain bike park.

*Activity Duration: 1-3 hours; half day. This activity is included in your stay.*

### GRIMSEY TOUR

Fly to an island in the Arctic Circle, located across the Troll Peninsula. Explore the home of just 90 people and one million seabirds. Inhabited since the Viking settlement of Iceland, courageous fishermen still live here. Glimpsed far out on the horizon, a blue cliff is surrounded by the wide Arctic Ocean, 40 km off the northern coast of Iceland. About 5 square kilometres, the island was formed by volcanic rock, resulting in beautiful basalt pillars. On a clear day experience 360 degree views of the Icelandic mainland.

*Activity Duration: Full day. Travel Time: 30-minute heli and/or charter flight, 3 hours by boat. This activity is available at an additional cost - Please inquire with the Experience Team for pricing.*

### SIGLUFJÖRÐUR TOUR

CHOCOLATE, BEER AND COFFEE?: Yes, please! Discover Frida, a local artist that fuses art with local chocolate and coffee. Once inside, don't miss the eclectic chairs, a bathroom wallpapered in cartoons, and cranberry-sea-salt chocolate. YUM.

ICELANDIC CRAFT BEER TASTING: Visit the local microbrewery, Segull 67, and meet the master brewer.

HERRING MUSEUM: This award winning maritime museum brings visitors back in time to Iceland's herring fishing heyday of the 1900's.

# HELI SKIING



Our heli-ski clients are Adventure Capitalists by design. They follow the snow, no matter the time of year. Getting after it is their call to action. Tackling untracked heli-ski descents on Iceland's Arctic maritime snowpack is for both the hard charger and the smooth cruiser. Sea-to-summit has never looked this good.

Heli-skiing on the Troll Peninsula is known for its beautiful rolling descents and steep couloirs taking you all the way to the ocean. This land of the midnight sun offers true adventurers extended daylight hours with more opportunity to rack up the vertical.

# HELI-SKIING

## WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

---

### ◀ **WHAT IS THE TERRAIN LIKE IN ICELAND? HOW ARE THE SNOW CONDITIONS?**

With over 1,500 square miles of terrain to ski, we have a wide variety of terrain – think wide open bowls, steep couloirs, long runs from mountain peaks to the ocean shore.

Iceland has a maritime snowpack meaning that the snow conditions are very stable. You can expect a variety of conditions – sometimes spring-like conditions including smooth, buttery slopes and corn snow; other times fresh powder.

### ◀ **DO YOU NEED TO BE AN EXPERT SKIER TO HELI SKI AT DEPLAR FARM?**

The vast terrain in Iceland means we have the flexibility to choose runs that are appropriate for your skill level. We recommend that guests be strong intermediate skiers to best enjoy the experience; for you experts out there, don't worry, there are plenty of challenging slopes for you to rip down.

### ◀ **WHEN IS THE BEST TIME TO HELI SKI IN ICELAND?**

Our season runs between March 15 - May 31. During this time we offer 4 and 6 day trips.

### ◀ **HOW MUCH FLIGHT TIME CAN WE EXPECT?**

We include one hour of flight time per day which equates to 8-10 runs; each run averages 2,500 - 3,500 feet of vertical.





## **FLY FISHING** FOR ATLANTIC SALMON

Looking to cross Iceland off your bucket list with an elevated angling experience? Northern Iceland is your headquarters from July to September. Eleven has access to some of the most exclusive salmon rivers in Iceland, and a world-class lodge to complete your experience. Eleven's fishing guides will design an itinerary to suit your goals and to give you the best chance at landing a prized Atlantic Salmon.

For centuries, Iceland has been attracting the best anglers of the world to fish its famous rivers. A unique attribute to fishing in Iceland is its commitment to conservation. Fishery associations are assigned to all waters, and they strictly regulate the natural fish stock and monitor the fishing pressure. Angling in Iceland is 100% catch and release and fly fishing only with a maximum of two rods per day.





## A FEW OF OUR FAVORITE RIVERS

### THE FLJÓTAÁ

The Fljótaá River, a world class Atlantic salmon and Arctic char river, is just 5 miles from Deplar Farm. The Fljótaá is only fished with 4 rods, so the fishing experience is very exclusive and the angler always has their pick of great pools. The river is narrow and fast flowing, perfect for light tackle.

### THE HÖLKNÁ

This two-rod river offers a unique opportunity for anglers to experience Atlantic salmon fishing, as exclusive as it gets. The two rods have access to an 8 mile stretch of gin-clear water, with 27 marked pools and a good number of unmarked pools. Hölkná is truly one of Iceland's up and coming rivers. Eleven's

Hölkná Cabins are located right on the banks of the river in the northeastern part of Iceland. They are as comfortable as they are remote.

### THE HÚSEYJARKVÍSL

The Húseyjarkvísl is one of the ultimate fishing destinations in Iceland. It is one of the few rivers that offers both world class salmon and sea trout fishing. The sea trout season starts in April and offers anglers the rare opportunity to heli-ski and catch trophy trout in the same day. Atlantic salmon are king in July and August. This three rod river is just an hour from Deplar Farm.



## ◀ WINTER ACTIVITIES

### **SIGLO RESORT SKIING**

Four lifts carry skiers up magnificent, seaside slopes. The top of the highest lift is over 650 meters above sea level. Once on top, cruise down gentle slopes or steeper inclines, with summit-to-sea descents and views of the surrounding Troll Peninsula.

*Activity Duration: 2-4 hours. Travel Time: 40 minutes. This activity is included in your stay.*

### **DOG SLEDDING**

Dog sledding in Iceland is an adventure not to be missed. Choose to either venture off property or have a private dog sledding experience at Deplar Farm.

*Activity Duration: 1-2 hours. Travel Time: 1.5 hours. This activity is available for an additional cost.*

### **SNOWSHOEING**

This is one of our favorite ways to explore the otherworldly landscape surrounding Deplar Farm. Navigate the nearby terrain with your guide via light snowshoes. Especially recommended after freshly-fallen snow.

*Activity Duration: 1-3 hours; half day. This activity is included in your stay.*

### **CROSS-COUNTRY SKIING**

The word “ski” derives from the old Norse word “skíð, which means “stick of wood.” Skiing started almost 4,000 years ago as a way to travel cross-country during winter. Continue the tradition while cross-country skiing from Deplar Farm through the scenic valleys of the Troll Peninsula.

*Activity Duration: 2-3 hours. This activity is included in your stay.*

### **TOM CAR TOUR**

Strap into a two-seat buggy with your co-pilot and bump and jump along Deplar's off-road paths. Our Tom Cars are equipped with 4-point safety harnesses and automatic transmission for easy navigation. All you need is an adventurous spirit and a valid driver's license.

*Activity Duration: 1 – 1.5 hours. Travel Time: 1.5 hours (summer 1 hour). This activity is included in your stay.*

### **WHITewater RIVER RAFTING**

Get ready for an adrenaline-fueled day on the water. Previous rafting experience is not needed to discover why the East Glacial River has become Iceland's signature whitewater rafting destination—ideal for various ages. Or, sign up for our family rafting trip in the West Glacial River. For those groups or families wanting a less heart-pounding ride, there are river adventures that still offer waterfalls yet no waves of consequence.

*Activity Duration: Full day. Travel Time: 50 minutes. This activity is available for an additional cost.*

### **LAKE FISHING**

Choose whether to fish with fly, spinner, or bait. Our guides will reveal top tips. All fishing gear, fishing permits and transport is included.

*Activity Duration: Half day. Travel Time: Dependent on location. This activity is included in your stay.*

### **SEA KAYAKING**

Sea kayaking is one of the most spectacular ways to become immersed in Iceland's stunning natural environment. The beauty of both land and sea takes a front-row seat as you kayak around the vibrant and stunning environment of the Siglufjörður area.

*Activity Duration: 2 – 3 hours. Travel Time: 45 minutes. This activity is included in your stay.*

### **HORSEBACK RIDING**

Viking settlers first brought the country's now-famous horses to Iceland during the 9th Century, when import of farm animals was forbidden. As a result, the original Nordic horse has remained a preserved purebred in Iceland. Though small, it's not a pony. The horses are still used to gather sheep during Fall, and horseback riding is a popular Icelandic sport. Icelandic horses are steady and obedient—a memorable way to experience stunning landscapes.

*Activity Duration: 1-3 hours. Travel Time: 20 minutes. This activity is included in your stay.*

### **DRANGEY TOUR**

This is a truly unique experience that combines sightseeing, bird watching, sailing, and hiking. Private guides will deliver Eleven Experience's high vibe energy as you discover an enchanting part of Iceland. In spring and summer, the island is a nesting colony for thousands of seabirds—puffins, guillemots, gannets, kittiwakes, fulmar, shearwaters, ravens, and gyrfalcons. A sheer sided aragonite rock (approximately 180m high), the island overlooks Skagafjörður. For the adventurer at heart, a legendary path to the top of the island uses ladders and ropes that run along the face of the cliffs. While hiking, get up close to local puffins. Tour guides reveal ancient stories of Grettir the Strong, a Viking that lived on the island in exile over 1,000 years ago, and explain how the island's resources have been harvested from past to present.

*Activity Duration: Dependant on weather and guest preference. This activity is available for an additional cost.*

### **LAKE MÝVATN TOUR**

This geothermal lake offers a one-of-a-kind natural environment of brilliant contrasts. Large open spaces with roads and walkways lead travelers to inspiring locales, where volcanic eruptions have played a crucial role in the formation of this landscape. Mývatn is an awe-inspiring geological area featuring hikes to volcanic craters, and natural hot springs.

*Activity Duration: Full day. Travel Time: 2.5 hours. This activity is available for an additional cost - Please inquire with the Experience Team for pricing.*





### **HÖLKNÁ - SALMON FISHING**

Considered a hidden gem, The Hölná in Northeast Iceland is a fantastic river for fly anglers, with one of the highest average catch rates for Atlantic salmon. Find more than 27 fishable pools over 10 kilometers, and with Eleven, enjoy exclusive access to the best fishing beats. This is 100-percent catch-and-release fishing, and fly-angling only. The season runs July 1 to September 1, and peaks July 13 to August 24, with a maximum of 2 rods per day. Separate lodge available for dining and entertainment.

### **FLJÓTAÁ - ARCTIC CHAR AND SALMON**

The Fljótaá River, aka “the little gem,” is our home turf. Eleven has access to four beats over 8 km, within a 10-minute drive from the lodge. Located near the east coast of Skagafjörður, the Fljótaá is a small and rewarding river, which runs through Miklavatn to the ocean. A fly fishing only river, the release of all salmon is mandated. Nearly 20-pound salmon are caught every season. As such, the Fljótaá offers the ultimate challenge.
