

SIX SENSES RESIDENCES COURCHEVEL

Six Senses Residences Courchevel takes traditional mountain living to new heights with meticulously designed interiors that combine contemporary accents with traditional Savoyard sensibility. The exterior is reminiscent of a French chalet while the residences' interiors are designed in a light neutral palate using unique and crafted materials with fine porcelain tiles, flamed gray and beige stone, chestnut leathers, and natural timber to imbue comfort. Each boasts a balcony offering picturesque views overlooking the snow-capped mountains or the intimate courtyard.

Location

Due to its high-altitude setting, Six Senses Residences Courchevel is open for winter activities from December through April. Located in the heart of Courchevel 1850, the Six Senses Residences Courchevel is a five-minute walk from the ski lodge at La Croisette and well-appointed to explore the village. The closest airport is the Courchevel Airport (CVF) which is approximately 1.3 miles away. Guests can also arrive by the Eurostar or TGV at the Moutiers Train Station 30-minutes away. A helicopter transfer is also available to Courchevel heliport.

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Accommodations

Two-Bedroom Apartments Mountain/Street view (67 to 86 sqm)

Located on the first, second and fourth floors, the Two-Bedroom Apartments boast Mountain and street views with a balcony and a quaint living space. Designed by Morpheus, each includes exposed timber and other natural materials accented with custom-made furniture and local artwork.

Two-Bedroom Apartments Courtyard View (65 to 83 sqm)

Located on the first floor, these peaceful Two-Bedroom Apartments boast courtyard views with a balcony and a quaint living space. Designed by Morpheus, each includes exposed timber and other natural materials accented with custom-made furniture and local artwork.

Three-Bedroom Family Apartment Mountain/Street View (78 to 95 sqm)

Located on the first and second floors, Three-Bedroom Family Apartments boast mountain and street views with a balcony and a spacious living space. Designed by Morpheus, each includes exposed timber and other natural materials accented with custom-made furniture and alpine artwork.

Three-Bedroom Prestige Family Apartment (109 to 155 sqm)

Located on the first, third, fourth, fifth and sixth floors, Three-Bedroom Prestige Family Apartments boast stunning valley and mountain views with private balconies and a spacious living area. Designed by Alain Foeillet, each feature timber walls and robust beams with stone and clay flooring accented by custom-made furniture and regional artwork.

Three-Bedroom Prestige Apartment (98 to 122 sqm)

Located on the third, fourth and sixth floors, the Three-Bedroom Prestige Apartments boast stunning valley, mountain, street or courtyard views with private balconies and terraces as well as spacious living area. Designed by Alain Foeillet, each feature timber walls and robust beams with stone and clay flooring accented by custom-made furniture and regional artwork.

Four-Bedroom Prestige Apartments (141 to 244 sqm)

Located on the second, third, fourth, seventh and eighth floors, A04, C03 and C07 are set as a duplex, while B04 is presented as a one-level Residence. These 4-Bedroom Prestige Residences boast stunning mountain views across the Valley, street, rooftop, courtyard and to the Slopes for B04. With private balconies and terraces of varying sizes. Not forgetting that each bedroom has an ensuite bathroom. Designed by Alain Foeillet, it captures a harmonious balance of contemporary interiors of light hues with striking accents of fine porcelain tiles (grès cérame) and flamed grey and beige stone. Sustainably sourced spruce timber is used for dramatic feature walls while heavy woven natural fabrics compliment soft furnishings to imbue comfort.

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Sumosan Courchevel [6]

Renowned Japanese restaurant Sumosan offers its signature sushi and contemporary Japanese dishes, the restaurant and bar provides a welcome antidote to the traditional fondue and raclette, with dishes exclusive to the site.

Buba's menu features signature Sumosan favourites served snow-side, including tuna and truffle rolls, Japanese salmon rice pizza, grilled sea bass with citrus ginger sauce and Furikakecrusted rack of lamb and mustard sauce. Whilst new, exclusive dishes will include black caviar rice pizza and torched sushi, such as squid with calamari ink powder and unagi with unagi cotton candy sauce - torched table-side.

Spa and Wellness

Six Senses Spa Courchevel offers residents guests and non-guests a healing oasis after an intensive day of skiing and activity. The Spa features an open-plan reception with the lounge area designed as a concept store with a manicure and pedicure station, juice bar and boutique seamlessly incorporated. There are five treatment rooms, an indoor swimming pool, saunas, steam room and Kneipp footbath therapy, outdoor hot tub and a fully equipped gym and studio for wellness classes.

Activities

Courchevel boasts some of the best alpine skiing and snowboarding in the world with groomed pistes and ski runs for different levels of experienced skiers and snowboarders. The Residence is supported by the Six Senses Concierge team dedicated to offering an extensive range of services including 24/7 concierge, in-resort shuttle services, private catering, event planning, ski instructors, childcare, dining reservations, private boutique viewing and bespoke transport solutions.

Ski Concierge

Six Senses Courchevel Residences is within a five-minute walk or two-minute shuttle ride from their private ski lodge situated at La Croisette (where the ski lifts start). The Lodge is fully equipped with ski rentals, heated boot racks as well as boutiques and cosy bars for après ski. Upon arrival, the Ski Concierge will take the guests' equipment to store it at the Ski Lodge. Servicing can be arranged overnight, so all is ready for guests to jump back on the slopes in the morning. A ski technician is on-site to make any adjustments.
