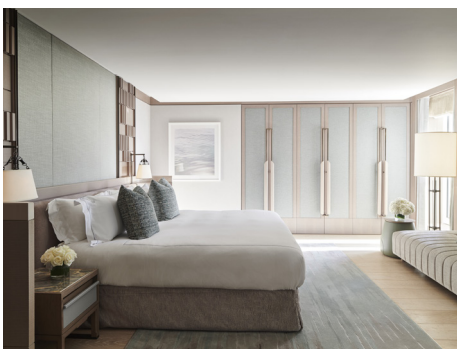

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BY AIR

London Heathrow is the city's main airport and is approximately 45 minutes' drive to the hotel. Gatwick is 1 1/2 hours away by car and London City Airport also serves the city.
